

SCORE BOARDS 2009

- New league rules for 2008 require that every Minor & Major team provide a person to keep the score board during their game. The league spends a lot of money and time to ensure that every field is equipped with a score board and speaker system; the league feels they should be used.
- The Home Team will be responsible to provide a person for its operation. Announcing the games is optional, but not required. Only keeping the score board is required.
- The key for the up-stairs area is located in the snack bar, or you see any board member to gain access.
- Coaches may use any parent, adult, and/or child 15 or older to keep the boards. Children 10 through 14 can only be used if they are on the approved list. The approved list is maintained in the snack bar, with a copy in the up-stairs area.
- Children ages 10 through 14 can easily get on the list by seeing any board member and then going through a 10 minute orientation on rules and operation (TBA). Children 10 through 14 can get their name on the list at any registration, practice, or game. - Score Boards will be discussed with all managers and coaches at the annual orientation.
- In the Minor Division the boards will stop keeping track of runs after 10 runs are scored. The balls, strikes, outs, etc will be kept throughout the whole game.
